

PGYMY BREED CHARACTERISTICS

COAT	Straight, medium long which varies with the seasons
COLOR	All are acceptable. The predominant is a grizzled agouti pattern produced by the intermingling of light and dark colors.
HEAD	Short to medium long. Profile is somewhat dished, muzzle rounded with a short nose that is wide and flat. Full chin and underjaw.
NECK	Well muscled, shorter rounder, more full throated than other breeds, more slender in females.
SHOULDER	Muscular, well angulated and well laid on
BACK	Strong, laterally straight, level along chine and loin rising slightly toward the iliac crest.
LOIN	Broad, strong, nearly level
RUMP	Medium long, medium wide, neither level nor steep
LEGS	Strong, well muscled, wide apart
HOCKS	Cleanly molded, sharply angled, metatarsus short
PASTERNS	Short, strong and resilient
FEET	Well shaped, portioned to size of animal; deep heel and level sole
BODY	Broad barrel shaped, deep and increasing in width toward flank
