GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Cattle may move into the Clark County Fairgrounds from Friday, March 11, noon until Saturday, March 12, 9:00 am and must be stalled in Barns 4 & 5.
2. Only steers and market heifers tagged for the 2011 Clark County Junior Fair are eligible to show. The exhibitor must be 8 years old and in the 3rd grade or must not have passed their 19th birthday as of January 1, 2011.
3. Steers, market heifers and heifers will be shown by shoulder height and breed.
4. Steers, market heifers and heifers will be shown by breed when there is a minimum of three (3) head for a given breed; all others will show by height and in a class called "Other Breeds".
5. Breed cattle must have original registration papers by 9:00 AM, Saturday, March 12.
6. Grooming supplies will be available on the grounds.
7. 2011 Clark County Junior Fair rules will be enforced.
8. The following grooming practices are prohibited in the market steer classes: Use of any substance to enhance or change the color of the livestock, including the livestock's hide or hooves; adding any substance externally to build up, change or alter the shape or conformation of the livestock, including by way of example but not limited to rope, false hair, graphite, hemp and powders; and/or pigmented grooming aides or materials. Each market beef will be checked for paint & pigmented materials before entering the show.
9. No alcoholic beverages permitted on the fairgrounds.
10. The Fair Board Office must approve any camping arrangements prior to the event.
Campers will be charged current fairgrounds overnight camping rate per night.
