1B. Enter your family's e-mail & the password you created in 4-H On-line.



1E. Click on the green button Register an Individual.






1F. The 4-H members connected to the family will appear. Click on the radio button of the first person you want to start making entries for Fair. Then, click on the green button "Continue".

1G. Read the exhibitor Code of Conduct question and mark your answer then click the green button "Continue".

Step 2: Choose the Department, Division and Class for your entry.

- 2A. Select Department First. Blossom is making a Jr. Fair Goat Entry. Click the green button "Select".
- 2B. Next select Division to show in. Blossom is making entry into the Market Production Show. Click the green button "Select".
- Division selected appears. Click the green button "Choose".







2H. You will then be asked to Choose an **Existing Animal Record or Enter a New Animal** Record. If you have not put any animals in the system. Click the green button, "Enter a New Animal Record".

- 2D. Select a class to continue. Click the green button "Select" next to the class you want to make entry. Blossom selects 402: Mkt. Prod. Doe Kid, born Feb. 2023.
- 2E. Screen will now show the Dept., Division and Class. If correct, click the green button, "Continue".



2F. Select the 4-H Club/FFA Chapter for this entry. When you click on the 4-H club/FFA chapter (the circle will go from O to ⊙).

Blossom selected Growing Clovers 4-H Club for this entry. The only clubs that will display for a 4-H member are the clubs the member is enrolled.


2i. When you click on Add a New Animal, a list of Animal Types to choose from will appear. Select the animal type to fill in the information for your animal. Blossom chose Goat Prod.



- **2J.** Complete the information for the animal you are making entry into the class. Then click on the green button "Create and Add Animal".
- **2K.** Your complete entry will appear with the member's name, dept., division, class entered and the animal's information, then click the green button "Continue".



Step 3: What Do You Want to Do Next?



3C. Click **Change Division** to move to another division within the Goat Department. Example: Market Production Goat Showmanship. **OR**

Click **Change Department** to move to a total different area like to Swine. Blossom made this change to make entry into Swine Showmanship in the Swine Department. Click the **green button**, "**Choose**" to select the change. You will then be prompted to select the Division and the Class within the Swine Department to make entry. **You do not need to select an animal for the showmanship classes.**



3E. You will then be prompted to repeat steps **3H**, **3i**, **3J** —where you either add a new animal or select an existing animal. After completing information for the animal, click on the **green button**, "**Create and Add Animal**.

Animal Information Varies By Project Area - YOU MUST have the information ready to enter when you start making entry. **Required** information identified below must be completed or the entry will not save. You can not go back in to add.

- Alpacas & Llamas Animal Name, Sex
- Beef Breeding Animal Name, Tag, Tattoo, Birthdate, Registration Number, Sex
- Beef Feeders Tag, Animal Name, Birthdate, Sex
- Dairy Females Animal Name, Birthdate, Registration Number, Dam Name, Sire Name, Tag, Tattoo
- Dogs Animal Name
- Dairy, Pygmy, Dwarf, Fiber and Market Production Goats Tag or Tattoo, Animal Name, Scrapie ID, Sex, Birthdate
- Horses Animal Name
- Market Hogs <u>CORRECT Ear Notch</u> (if you don't know it or can't read it, contact your breeder to get the right ear notch), <u>pigs whose ear notches do not match their Fair Entry at weigh-in will be evaluated by the Swine Committee to determine eligibility to show</u>, Breed, Breeder Name, E-mail and Cell Phone) in Description for market hogs entered in Co. Farrowed.


- Dairy Females Grade and Crossbred Animals will need to upload a photo. Registered Animals will need to upload registration papers.
- Beef Breeding, Market Beef Breed Steers, Market Hog Breed -Upload registration papers or show registration papers at weigh-in.
- Dogs Upload current county dog license and vaccination record or show at Dog Skill-a-thon on (June 27) or at Fair.
- Market Hogs <u>Upload 2 photos a side profile and a head shot clearly showing both ear's notches.</u>

- **3A.** After each entry, a screen will appear "What do you want to do next?
- Click Add Another Entry, to make more entries for the SAME EXHIBITOR. OR
- Click Register Another Exhibitor to switch to another child in your family.
- **3B.** Blossom selects to add another entry. The same department and division will appear.




3D. Select the Class you want to enter in the department and division. Click the **green button**, "**Select**" and then the **green button**, "**Continue**"





3F. The complete entry will appear and if you have made any mistakes you have the opportunity to edit the entry by clicking on the **Edit Animal Details** or even to delete the entry. If correct click on the **green button**, "**Continue**".





Making Open Class Entries, Fair Passes, Fair Coins and More.

- 5A. Go to http://ClarkCountyFairOhio.fairentry.com
- **5B.** Create a Fair Entry Account for Open Class. Once you have created an account, you will be able to make entry in any open class department.
- **5C.** Anyone making entry into Open class including Jr. Fair members (4-H and FFA) will be required to purchase a \$5 exhibitor's fee which includes one single day ticket.
- 5D. 4-H and FFA members can purchase Fair wristbands for \$10/member Tues., July 18-Thurs., July 20, 9 AM to 8 PM at the Fair Office. The wristband serves as your admission into and out of the Fairgrounds. One day ride bands will also be available for purchase for \$10 at the same time.
- **5E.** Fair Coins worth **\$8 each** earned by 4-H members for projects completed through Skill-a-thon, Miscellaneous and Shooting Sports Project Judging will be given out during fair pass pick-up. Use Fair Coins like cash during Fair week on the Fairgrounds.

Important Information

- **4A.** Enrolled 4-H Project Required for 4-H Members 4-H members can only make entry into departments, divisions and classes with an enrolled 4-H project.
- If a 4-H member tries to enter into a department, division or class without being enrolled with a 4-H project, a screen like the one to the left will appear.

4B. Making Multiple Entries

Youth will be able to enter each horse, dog, alpaca and/or llama they plan to show in multiple classes at one time. You will be able to review all the entries you created and either accept or cancel based on your selections.

By Midnight May 15: All Market Hog Entries (no late entries), All FFA Dept. and FFA Member Profile for All FFA Members Planning on Exhibiting Anything at the Clark County Fair By Midnight June 1: Dairy Calves, Heifers and Cows, Cart, Dairy, Dwarf, Fiber, Pygmy and Market Production Goats

By Midnight July 1: Alpacas, Llamas, Beef Breeding and Beef Feeders, Dogs and Horses

By Midnight July 1: All Showmanship - You do not need to select an animal for showmanship.

By Midnight July 1: Jr. Fair Auction Entry

• 4D. Please do not make entry for these animals.

All: Market Beef, Market Dairy Steers, Meat Turkeys, Meat Chicken, Meat Duck, Fancy & Egg Production Poultry, Market Lambs, Market Goats, All Cavies, All Rabbits, All Dairy Feeders.

We will make these entries for all 4-H and FFA members based on bulk orders, tag-in, weigh-in, I.D. Day, Exhibitor Registration Qualtrics Surveys, etc.

Please do not make entries for these 4-H projects.
