Frames must be able to hang on an S hook (frames need to have an eyelet or wire). Photos that do not meet the criteria will not be judged or displayed.
- Deliver, enter and pick-up entries same during Club Booth set-up and tear down on Friday.
- Photographs not picked up at tear down will be disposed of by the committee.

Judging Criteria: Entries judged on the following criteria: lighting, lines, interest, message, background, off-center and the ability to connect to the class theme.
