4-H	418	400	USA Landmarks – Utilize Lego, building blocks, Knex, Lincoln logs, etc. to create a recognizable U.S.A landmark (example Statue of Liberty).
4-H	418	401	All American Container – Decorate a container to show your pride in America. Containers could hold plants, serve as a storage bin, desk caddy, etc.
4-H	418	402	Upcycle Funk - repurpose something old into something new, create art from junk.
4-H	418	403	American Flag Crafts – Use any art media to create an American flag art piece.
4-H	418	404	Red, White & Blue Tie Dye – Any item made using a tie dye process.
4-H	418	405	2026 Picasso – draw, sketch or paint a picture of your choosing on paper, wood, metal or canvas.
4-H	418	406	Patriotic Cake Decorating - not to exceed 8-inch any shape Styrofoam base with any icing style – no real cakes or bakery based products.
4-H	418	407	No Sew Art - Create a piece of art using thread, string, fabric, felt, leather, suede, yarn, etc. that does not require any sewing.
4-H	418	408	Techy Art – Make a piece of art using technology included but not limited to things made with 3-D printers, computers, sublimation, laser engravers, paper circuits, robotics, etc.
4-H	418	409	DIY Game Art - Repurpose old games, cards and game pieces into works of art, jewelry, etc.
4-H	418	410	Solar Art - create a piece of art that catches the sun rays (sun catchers, solar print art, etc.)

Requirements: Member may enter one entry per class. Members must have created the creative masterpiece entry.

Judging Criteria: Entries judged on the use of color, texture, line, form, space, movement & value.
