

Day. If purebred cavy, bring pedigree if obtained or knowledge of age to Cavy I.D. Day. All cavy(s) must have a tag in their left ear or have one placed on this date to be eligible to show at the Fair. Pet cavies can be mixed breed of any age. If a registered cavy dies before June 1st, it may be replaced by June 1st provided the member notifies the Extension Office at 937-398-7599 or e-mail house.18@osu.edu. The exhibitor must contact a Rabbit & Poultry Committee member to have the replacement cavy identified with a tag in the left ear. If a cavy loses, its ear tag, you must notify the Ext. Office at 937-398-7599 or house.18@osu.edu, the committee will contact the exhibitor to retag the cavy. Cavies without tags at Fair will not show. ◆ QA: Members are not required to attend a QA to show at Fair. ◆ Skill-a-thon/Project Judging: You must participate in the Clark County 4-H Skill-a-thon/Project Judging to complete your cavy project and show at the Clark County Fair. ◆ Miscellaneous Project Judging: If you wish to be eligible for Ohio State Fair, you must participate in Misc. Project Judging too. ◆ Project Book Work: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Select at least 5 activities in your project level to complete. Complete the following sections based on your project level: Member Project Guide, Animal Care, Welfare, An. Records. Participate in learning, leadership and citizenship activities. <p>Skill-a-thon/Project and Miscellaneous Judging Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Project Book: Bring project and record book with completed activities to project judging/skill-a-thons and/or misc. judging. ◆ Feed Info: Attach food label(s) fed to your cavy(s) in your project and record book. ◆ Project Interview: Answer general 4-H, project related and care of your cavy(s) questions. ◆ Study: Cavy project book and Resource Handbook to prepare for skill-a-thon and/or miscellaneous project judging. ◆ Project Display: Choose a topic related to your cavy project and put together an educational display and bring with you to Miscellaneous Project Judging. ◆ State Fair Selection: 2 members may be selected in each of the following State Fair Classes, Cavy ages 8-12 and Cavy ages 13-18. 215 Cavy Project and Record Book		<p>Fair Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Fair Entries: Jr. Fair management will make entry for cavy classes based on information collected through the Cavy Exhibitor On-Line Registration and the Cavy I.D. Day. ◆ Fair Classes: Cavy(s) will be judged by ARBA rules and breed standards. Members may show a maximum of 10 purebred. Classes are shown by breed all ages with sows and boars in separate classes. Pet cavy classes do not require a pedigree. ◆ Breeds: The following breeds can be shown: Abyssinian, Abyssinian Satin, American, American Satin, Coronet, Peruvian, Peruvian Satin, Silkie, Silkie Satin, Teddy, Teddy Satin, Texel, White Crested. ◆ Showmanship: Exhibitors will show by age as of January 1st of the current fair year in two age divisions: Junior, age 8 and in 3rd grade to age 13 and Senior age 14 to age 18. Cavy exhibitors are not eligible for the Showman of Showmen competition unless there are 20 or more cavy exhibitors at the current Fair. ◆ Health Papers: Not required for show at the fair. All cavy(s) must be free of contagious/infectious disease. ◆ Cavy Arrival, Check-In, Departure: Cavy's may arrive between 7:30 AM and 8:30 AM, Saturday, July 20 in the Rabbit Barn. Exhibitors must take their cavy(s) home at the conclusion of the cavy show. ◆ Barn Rules: While at the fair, <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. Exhibitors are required to bring their own carriers/cages to house their cavy(s). B. Exhibitors must provide food, water and appropriate equipment to keep their cavy(s) cool. ◆ Dress Code: All cavy exhibitors SHOULD wear long pants, club/ chapter or collared shirt and closed toed shoes. Lab coats may be worn, but not required. ◆ Cavy Cage Display: Make entry by midnight July 1 on Fair Entry. Set up static cavy display in assigned cage at Fair by Friday, July 19 7 PM. No live cavies! Display judged on cavy experiences, educational message conveyed and eye appeal. <p>Clark Co. Miscellaneous & State Fair Exhibit Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Bring to Judging: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. Educational display on a topic from your learning activities. And B. Completed and up-to-date project book with photos documenting Your cavy(s) and experiences included but not limited to handling, grooming, feeding, cleaning cage and equipment, etc. 	<p>Misc.
