Sr. Dairy Goat milk will sell in the Champion Showcase, if goats are in milk production.</p> <p><b>Dairy or Pygmy-Type Showman of Showmen Rep</b> The Sr. exhibitor with the top skill-a-thon score between the Sr. Pygmy-Type Goat and the Sr. Dairy Goat Showmanship winner will be the rep. in Showman of Showmen.</p> <p><b>Market Goat Showman of Showmen Rep:</b> The Sr exhibitor with the top skill-a-thon score between the Sr. Market Goat and the Sr. Market Production Goat Showmanship winner will be the rep in Showman of Showmen.</p> <p><b>Premier Exhibitor:</b> Market production exhibitors are eligible to earn points for Premier Exhibitor. Office</b>.</li> <li>Dairy and dwarf-type dairy doe must be disbudded. Market prod. doe doesn't.</li> <li>Jr dairy goats (doe born this year or dry yearling doe). No bucks!</li> <li>Senior Dairy Goat projects - doe one year and older in milk production, dry doe 2 years and older and/or Mother/daughter pair.</li> <li>Market Goat Production projects - doe of the current year or older.</li> <li>Mother/daughter or Mother/Wether pair may also be a project.</li> <li>Dwarf-type dairy doe and wether of any age may be shown.</li> </ol> </li> <li>◆ <b>QA:</b> Only members with lactating dairy goat projects <b>are required</b> to attend an annual QA Program <b>by June 1</b> to show at the Clark Co or Ohio State Fair.</li> <li>◆ <b>Skill-a-thon/Project Judging:</b> You <b>must participate</b> in the Clark Co. 4-H Skill-a-thon/Project Judging to complete your project and show at the Clark County and/or Ohio State Fairs.</li> <li>◆ <b>Project Work:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Select at least 5 activities in your project level and complete.</li> <li>Complete QA and Animal Records for your project level.</li> <li>Participate in learning, leadership and citizenship activities.</li> <li>Study one or more topics of interest in the Resource book.</li> </ol> </li> </ul> <p><b>Skill-a-thon/Project Judging Requirements:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ <b>Project Book:</b> Bring project book (135) with completed activities.</li> <li>◆ <b>Feed Info:</b> Attach feed tag(s)/farm ration fed in your record book.</li> <li>◆ <b>Project Interview:</b> Answer general 4-H, project related, goat care questions.</li> <li>◆ <b>Study:</b> Goat Res. A doe due to kid in July can't show. <b>Birthdates and scrapie tags required.</b> Check Jr. Fair Book for all classes.</li> <li>◆ <b>Pen Requests:</b> Due July 1<sup>st</sup> on your 4-H Club's Fair Pen Form.</li> <li>◆ <b>Goat Arrival and Release: Must arrive by 7 PM, Fri., July 19 and may leave at the end of the show.</b></li> <li>◆ <b>DUNF:</b> Complete and submit on-line per lactating dairy goat by noon, 7/19/24.</li> <li>◆ <b>Check-In Required to Show: Goats must be checked-in Fri., July 19, 5 pm-7 pm outside goat barn 1.</b></li> <li>◆ <b>Showmanship:</b> Must use own goat. Must be a goat shown in the dairy show for dairy showmanship or market prod. show for mkt. prod. showmanship.</li> <li>◆ <b>Health Rules:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No health papers required. Animals must show no symptoms or evidence of an infectious or contagious disease at fair.</li> </ol> </li> <li>B. <b>Official USDA Scrapie ear tag/tattoo/electronic chip required for all dairy goats.
