Lab coats and long sleeve shirts may be worn to prevent scratches, but not required.</p> <p>Barn Rules: Furnish own bedding (no cedar shavings) and feed. No locks on cages! Clean pens daily by 9 AM and keep aisles cleaned. Pens and cages will be inspected daily to ensure that all birds are properly cared for by the exhibitor (i.e. – fed, watered, clean bird and pen, etc.). Pens and birds not cared for will be tagged with a colored card. No pullets! ♦ Skill-a-thon/Project Judging: <u>Must participate</u> in the county 4-H Skill-a-thon/Project Judging to complete project and show at the Clark County and Ohio State Fairs. ♦ Project Book Work: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A. Select at least 5 activities in your project level and complete. B. Complete QA and Animal Records for your project level. C. Participate in learning, leadership and citizenship activities. D. Study one or more topics of interest in the Resource book. <p>Skill-a-thon/Project Judging Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ♦ Project Book: Bring up-to-date project and record book. ♦ Feed Info: Attach feed tag(s)/ration fed to birds in project book. ♦ Project Interview: Answer questions about your project including general 4-H, project book and care of your poultry. ♦ Study: Use your project book, Skill-a-thon and QA Kits to prepare. <p>Fair Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ♦ Pen Requests: Pens for birds must be requested by July 1st on the Club's Pen Request Form and returned to Ext. Office. ♦ Fair Exhibit: May only exhibit one breed of egg production birds, total of three (3) birds per exhibitor. May only exhibit one dozen eggs from the one breed of egg production birds exhibited. Egg production hens and one dozen eggs will be shown in the ring at the same time, but judged separately with separate placings and awards given. ♦ Identification and Fair Entry: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A. Must complete the Fancy & Egg Production Poultry Exhibitor on-line registration by midnight, June 25. Go to https://go.osu.edu/2024clarkcojrfairfancyandprodpoetryexhreg B. Must bring any fancy or egg production bird you plan to show at the 2024 Clark County Fair to the Fancy & Egg Production Poultry I.D. Day on June 26, 5 PM to 8 PM to be issued a leg band, Pullorum tested and to verify correct show class and breed. Cost is \$2/bird. ♦ Health Rules: All birds must be free of contagious or infectious disease including lice and mites. ♦ Replacement: Any poultry that experience an unforeseen accident/illness between Fair check in and show may be replaced by the exhibitor with another one from your own flock. ♦ Bird Arrival and Release: Arrive by 4 PM-7 PM, 7/19/24, Release time Tues., July 23, Noon-6 PM. Clean pens out by 6:30 PM on Tues., July 23. Failure to clean/tear down pens will result in \$50 per pen charge club. ♦ Check-In: 4 PM-7 PM, Fri., July 19 in the Poultry Barn ♦ Req. Equipment Before Cooping: Waterers: Plastic milk jugs or two liter bottles fastened to the cage. Feeders: same as water containers or heavy large plastic cups. No Paper, Styrofoam or Solo drinking cups. No zip ties.
