DO NOT LIST THE SAME PIGS FOR SIBLINGS! 2 Photos – one side profile and one head shot with ear notches visible must be uploaded onto Fair Entry for each pig you make entry for on Fair Entry. ♦ Project Animal Replacements: If a member's pig dies more than 60 days prior to Fair weigh-in, he/she may replace the dead pig if the Ext. Office 937-398-7599 or email house.18@osu.edu is notified within the first work day after the hog dies and the dead hog is inspected by a Swine Com. member. If a project market hog dies less than 60 days prior to the first day of the Fair, an exhibitor may exhibit, show and sell a market hog identified on a sibling's Fair Entry from the same household. Household means permanent residence address of exhibitor. ♦ Ear Notching: Market hogs must be ear notched for I.D. purposes. ♦ Youth QA Requirement: Market hog project members are required to attend an annual Youth Quality Assurance Program by June 1 to show and/or sell at the Clark County and/or Ohio State Fairs. ♦ Skill-a-thon/Project Judging: You must participate in the Clark Co. 4-H Skill-a-thon/Proj. Judging to show at the Clark Co. and/or Ohio State Fairs ♦ Project Book Work: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Select a min. of five activities in your project level to complete. Complete the QA and Animal Records Section based on project level. Participate in learning, leadership and citizenship activities. Study one or more topics of interest in the Swine Res. 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<p>139 Market Hogs</p> <p>Grooming and Prohibited Practices: All animals giving evidence of any unacceptable practices or prohibited grooming practices as outlined in 901-19-13 and 901-19-33 of Ohio's Livestock Tampering Exhibition Rules will be barred from competition at the Clark County Fair. Drenching of livestock at an exhibition is prohibited except as permitted for a medical condition when diagnosed by a licensed veterinarian. Drenching means the act of using an instrument, including a bottle, placed in an animal's mouth to orally administer a liquid, food, or any other Substance.</p>	<p>Grooming Rules: Slick clipping and body shaving is prohibited except on ears and tails.</p> <p>All 4-H and FFA market hogs will be evaluated for ½ inch hair length on the body prior to going on the scales at Fair weigh-in.</p> <p>Any hog found to have questionable hog hair-length at weigh-in, during any show or anytime during the Fair will be checked further by a sub-committee of the Swine Committee, Sr. Fair Board and the Fair Veterinarian.</p> <p>Show, auction and award disqualifications will result for any hog found by the Committee with less than ½ in. hair at any time during Fair.</p> <p>There will be no clipping or snaring of hogs on the fairgrounds.</p> <p>Barn Rules: No Fans! Clean Out Pens! Use Shavings or Sawdust. No straw! Dumping manure in unauthorized areas can result in not showing and/or selling.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Weight Requirements: Only one trip per pig across the scales. Exhibitors with market hogs weighing in under 200 pounds and over 300 pounds are not eligible to show in the Jr. Show, County Farrowed or Showman or Showmen Contest. ◆ Health Rules: Health papers and pseudorabies test not required if the hogs originated within Ohio. Hogs born or purchased outside of Ohio must have a vet health cert. and be neg. to a pseudorabies. ◆ Drug Use Notification Form On-Line Survey: The exhibitor and his/her parent/legal guardian must complete and sign a Drug Use Notification Form (DUNF) on-line survey by 30 minutes after weigh-in on each of his/her market hogs. ◆ After Exhibition Animal Declaration Form On-Line Survey: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A. Must complete an "After Exhibition Animal Declaration Form" indicating where each market hog is headed after exhibition. This on-line survey must be completed/signed no later than 30-minutes after weigh-in. B. Serves to assist the Swine Committee, Sale Mgt. & Fair personnel in tracking where market hogs need to go after the conclusion of exhibition thus helping to reduce load-out, custom and packer mishaps. C. Failure to complete and sign by the designated deadline will result in forfeiture of the right to sell a hog in the Clark Co. Jr. Livestock Auction. ◆ Declaring Market Hogs To Go Home: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A. Exhibitor must identify on the Animal Declaration On-Line Survey due by 30 minutes after weigh-in which market hog(s) they are taking home. B. Load out declared take home pigs on Sunday, Monday, or Tuesday of Fair between 8 PM and 9 PM at the loading chute at rear of show arena. ◆ Show and Sale Ring Requirements: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A. MUST use your own animal for showmanship. B. Show and sell your own market hog(s) unless you have permission prior to the show/sale for another Jr. Fair exhibitor to show/sell. ◆ Auction: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A. Each exhibitor may participate in the Auction with ONE UNIT (OVERALL JR. FAIR ELIGIBLE MARKET EXPERIENCE). This unit consists of all eligible market projects in the Clark Co. Jr. Fair Auction (live or on-line) except for Champions. B. Overall Grand and Overall Reserve Champion Market Hog and Scramble Champions must sell in the Sale of Champions and if an exhibitor has multiple champions they will sell all champions. C. Overall Premier Exhibitor may sell in the Sale of Champions but are not required to do so unless also one of the Champions. D. Members with Scramble hogs must sell that hog in the Auction. E. Exhibitors to sell in the Sale of Champions will need to move their Champion animals to the designated Hall of Champions area on the day 	<p>Jr Swine Com.
