Clark County 4-H Families and Volunteers:

Ohio Youth Livestock Exhibition Rules Effective March 1, 2023

In addition to OAC 901-19 and the Clark County Jr. Fair Rules, any 4-H or FFA members planning on exhibiting and showing must meet the expectations in the updated Ohio Youth Livestock Exhibition Rules. Please make sure you read these rules and take appropriate actions. The rules are posted at https://clark.osu.edu/program-areas/4-h-youth-development/clark-county-fair and on the 4-H App.

Important Ohio 4-H Shooting Sports Policy Updates

All Clark County 4-H Shooting Sports Instructors, Jr. Leaders and Members need to abide by the updated Ohio 4-H Shooting Sports Program General Information, Definitions and Policies document. This document is posted on the Projects Requirement Page under Shooting Sports https://clark.osu.edu/program-areas/4-h-youth-development/project-requirements and on the 4-H App.

Ohio 4-H Club Minimum Requirements

All Clark County 4-H clubs are required to meet Ohio 4-H Club Minimum Requirements. A document outlining those requirements are posted at https://clark.osu.edu/program-areas/4-h-youth-development/clubs and on the 4-H App. Key highlights include:

- Offer a minimum of 6 club meetings.
 Clark County 4-H members must attend at least 6 club meetings and/or approved activities (4-H kick-off, skill-a-thon/project judging, clinics, club community service event, club/county fundraising event, etc.).
 Members must meet this requirement to be eligible to participate in the Clark County and/or Ohio State Fair.
- Have at least 5 members from 3 different families and 3 of the members must be at least 8 years
 of age and in the 3rd grade.
- Are advised by approved 4-H volunteers.
- Have a club constitution and by-laws and have completed the Ohio 4-H Charter Checklist to be issued a 4-H Club Charter. Club Charter Checklist is due by April 15, 2023 to the Extension Office.
- Elect officers annually. Only project eligible members can hold officers.
- Have an EIN number whether the club handles money or not.
- Members enroll in at least one project.
- Cloverbuds participate in activity based programming and enroll in 710 as Cloverbuds.
- If the club handles money, only members can handle money and participate in fundraising that includes the countywide fundraisers.

Reporting Child Abuse and Neglect

All Clark County 4-H volunteers are required by the 4-H Volunteer Standards of Behavior and the OSU Youth Activities & Programs Child Abuse & Neglect Recognition and Reporting Policy (1.50). If a 4-H volunteers suspects or a disclosure has been made by a youth to a 4-H volunteer, the 4-H volunteer MUST report.

These are the actions the 4-H volunteer MUST COMPLETE:

- Call 911 or Children's Services Hotline 855-642-4453 (855-OH-CHILD)
- Call Patty House at 937-398-7599 to complete an on-line written report to Ohio State University within 1 business day of calling 911 or Children's Service. https://go.osu.edu/reportabuse

We all have a role to play in helping to prevent child abuse and neglect. Even if you are not a 4-H volunteer and you suspect or a child discloses to you abuse or neglect, we all of a moral and ethical duty to report.
